### SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

The WASH Deputy Program Manager (PM) will be a driving force for the success of all SP's water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) activities in Mayendit County, Unity State, and South Sudan alongside the WASH PM. This involves supervising the current WASH program, as well as developing new proposals and budgeting for new programming opportunities. The Deputy WASH PM will organize and oversee training and mentorship of other field staff. The Deputy PM will work closely with local government and community leaders for implementation and partnership of SP's WASH program.

### MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Act as WASH PM in his absence, managing all activities of the WASH program, ensuring compliance with SP & grantor guidelines and following best practices.
- Prepare concept notes, proposals, and budgets for future projects alongside the WASH PM.
- Develop work plans for WASH staff to ensure activities and objectives are completed on time and monitor progress through regular field visits.
- Train WASH staff on curriculum, teaching methods, and workshop facilitation.
- Manage and support all WASH staff, ensuring they are productive employees contributing the goals of the program and organization.
- Coordinate meetings, campaigns, trainings and events with community leaders, WASH committees, and staff.
- Prepare appropriate designs for sanitation and hygiene infrastructures including shared household latrines.
- Submit regular reports on time based on the reporting schedule according to internal and external requirements alongside the WASH PM.
- Attend daily morning devotions and participate in prayer support for the ministry, its donors and volunteers.
- Maintain a strong Christian witness to colleagues, vendors, charitable beneficiaries, and the general public.
- Ensure that appropriate performance appraisal and coaching are practiced within the department to enhance staff relations and accountability.

## KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- Two to three years field experience in the related field.
- Proven ability to coordinate and manage staff, finances and project activities.
- Must be proficient in Microsoft Office Programs and have strong mathematical and reasoning abilities.
- Be a strong team player and adapt at creating a strong team spirit.

- Ability to work with culturally diverse groups of people.
