Organization background

The Confident Children Out of Conflict (CCC) is a national organization founded in 2007 as a response to the needs of orphaned, other vulnerable street children and young adult women. Many of these children were staying at the cemetery sites, salakana, gumbo, rakubas, Mahad, Lologo, Korbou...

CCC provides 100 Children with shelter, food and clean water and education and another 766 children at community settings to go t school. These kids are here to be helped to develop, go to school, and learn some entrepreneurship skills in order to help themselves, their families and community at large. Without this care, these children would remain on the streets, unproductive, exploited sexually, subjected to early marriages, child labour, trafficking and all sorts of Gender based violence.

## Overall role

A social worker advocates for others, be they young or old. Work with clients from every station in life, and sometimes dire economic backdrops, to ease them through transitions, hardships, and mentally tough times.

A Social will be the person who assists them in finding the proper resources to get the care or supplement they need to sustain a certain quality of life. You may also be the link between people and caregivers in the health and psychology professions. As a social worker, you'll find reward, take risks, and offer viable options for those who may not be capable—or willing—to help themselves.
