

COUNTRY PROGRAM MISSION:

The overall objective of the **Help – Germany** in South Sudan program is to assist the South Sudanese to respond and react to community WASH needs. To achieve this objective, Help - Germany implements a multisectoral program that includes Food Security & Livelihood, Nutrition, WASH as key activities. Help - Germany currently works closely with the County WASH Departments in large scale county wide WASH and nutrition programming. Help's Nutrition and Food Security programming is expanding its outreach mechanisms and introducing new initiatives. Help - Germany has program activities in Former Central Equatoria and Lakes.

PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE POSITION:

Based in Nimule but with frequent travel & significant presence in IDPS in various locations in Central Equatoria (approx. 50%), the **Public Health Engineer** is responsible for the supervision of WASH activities in particular Sanitation, Drilling & Rehabilitation of Boreholes, construction of shelters and permanent latrines .

Key Tasks & Responsibilities:

- Responsible for needs assessment; House to House campaign planning, implementation and monitoring at household level.
- Drafts bills of quantities (BOQs) and technical Latrine/shelter drawings for use by contractors.
- Supervise drilling & rehabilitation of boreholes, open/hand dug wells.
- Participate in field missions and reports any findings.
- Compile and produce reports on weekly basis.
- Remain updated on technical and legal considerations (of national laws, standards and codes)
- Participate in Help e.V staff seminars and training, when scheduled.
- To provide information to the target population on ways of preventing the most significant water and sanitation diseases.
- To visit the target population to discuss the importance of using and constructing latrines, disposing of feces and hand washing and any other issues as determined by the project coordinator.

- To raise awareness about the importance of using family latrine.
- To encourage people in building and use family latrines, clean and maintain them through CLTS intervention.
- Provide information for monitoring and evaluation purposes in the form of verbal or written.
- Feedback, attending regular meetings with other team members and project coordinator, and written documentation.
- Follow up and supervise latrine/shelter construction and decommissioning of filled up latrines in consideration of technical specifications, quality and timeframe as well as provision of certificates of completion through the WASH Coordinator.
- Assessment: identify risk practices, select practices for intervention, define the target audiences, and select communication channels.

Qualifications

- Diploma/Degree in Environmental Health/Civil engineering or related qualification
- Previous work experience with at least 3 years of satisfactory performance in the same or similar functional area preferably with UN or INGOs.
- 3 years' experience in supervising Boreholes drilling and permanent latrines construction.
- Good Computer literacy (MS word, MS excel, AutoCAD & ArchiCAD)
- Fluency in English and Arabic, knowledge of Local language is an added advantage.

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to organize and prioritize work
- Ability to work under pressure and meet deadlines
- Ability to resolve individual and group conflicts
- High level of computer literacy
- Good Capacity Building and community mobilization and skills
