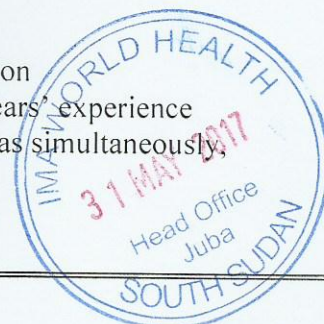
Duties:

Essential Functions:

- Provide essential clinical care to patients in outpatient and inpatient wards.
- Ensure all patients are attended to by the right health workers, promptly and in a professional manner.
- Lead daily rounds in the in-patient ward.
- Identify the training needs of nurses and other junior personnel, ensuring they receive appropriate training by conducting continuous medical education (CME) during ward rounds.
- Participate in timely and accurate daily, weekly, monthly collection & submission of epidemiological reports.
- Continuously monitor the use of standardized health management information system and forms/tools for data collection, analysis and reporting.
- Ensure correct usage of treatment protocol and proper management of all medical materials and equipment at the hospital.
- Provide appropriate health education to all patients attending outpatient clinic.
- Work closely with the laboratory team to ensure that patients are appropriately investigated and results released on time with emphasis on confidentiality.
- Supervise activities in the OPD including nutrition screening and injection rooms.
- Ensure compliance with referral system among supervised staff, including entry of referral forms into appropriate register books, completion of feedback forms of referring facilities, and follow up, as required of discharged patients.
- Ensure rational use of the drugs.
- Perform any other duty assigned by line manager.

- Diploma in clinical medicine and Public Health training from a recognized institution
- Registered Clinical Officer, holding a valid Practicing Certificate, with at least 2 years' experience
