The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assists the Juba Military Hospital operation and maintenance team leader;
- Assesses the operation and maintenance needs according to WatHab criteria by collecting all relevant information regarding the condition of Juba Military Hospital facilities, equipment, and systems;
- Implements the operation and maintenance schedule;
- Monitors project implementation for compliance with project documents, ICRC standards, and local building codes/standards, and ensures corrective action taken if necessary;
- Manages labour and undertakes material procurement according to the delegation's rules on financial management and procurement procedures;
- Compiles site reports on project implementation at intervals set by the Team Leader.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Technical vocational training, apprenticeship (in plumbing, electricity, masonry or related discipline)
- 1-2 years of experience (post training) in plumbing, masonry, electrical installation or related discipline.
- If not certified, s/he should have 3-4 years of experience.
- Advanced conversational English and Arabic.
- Working level in computer skills including MSOffice
- Familiarity with the standard norms and rules in construction, local techniques and requirements for construction.
- Experience in assessing, surveying, calculating and preparing estimates and technical drawings of buildings.
