JOB SUMMARY

Based in Guit the Senior Reproductive Health officer will work under the direct supervision of County Health Coordinator and take the overall responsibility of coordination and management of the daily activities of the Reproductive Health units of the PHCC

Main responsibilities



- i. Provide overall Reproductive Health technical oversight of all activities to ensure interventions is evidence based culturally appropriate, cost-effective, and high impact.
- ii. Assist County Health Coordinator and Senior Public Health Officer in operationalizing the RH strategy and facilitate community participation in Reproductive Health program,
- iii. Build technical capacity of the service providers, Traditional Birth Assistants and communities
- iv. Manage Reproductive Health initiatives both at the community and Health Facilities level,
- v. Assist the County Health Coordinator and Senior Public Health Officer to develop, review, and disseminate guidelines, standards of practice, protocols and other tools to improve quality delivery of RH at Health Facility and Community level
- vi. Disseminate best practices at community level to community elders, Traditional Birth Attendants and women groups
- vii. Hold regular community meeting and FGD's on family planning, facility delivery and create awareness on availability of RH services including ASRH and S/GBV response and prevention
- viii. Participate in development, preparation, and dissemination of IEC materials.
- ix. Assist with development of behavior change messages around Reproductive Health.

Requirements

- i. 2-3 years managing Reproductive projects in conflict/post-conflict countries,
- ii. 1 year experience in managing staff ensuring a good quality of reproductive health services,
- iii. Technical expertise in the components of integrated Reproductive Health, quality improvement, and other selected RH/FP services through NGO
- iv. Have excellent facilitation skill and experienced in building capacity of staff, both internally and externally.
- v. Demonstrated ability to liaise with relevant stakeholders, including government officials, community leaders, and health service providers.
- vi. Demonstrated capacity to oversee development of work plans and report preparation
- vii. Excellent written and interpersonal communication skills,
- viii. Demonstrated cross-cultural, teamwork, and computer skills,
- ix. Maintain a positive working relationship with clients and colleagues and embrace professionalism, team work, integrity and medical work ethics
- x. Actively promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within CHADO and amongst beneficiaries served by CHADO



- xi. Must be flexible and able to work in a challenging environment with limited resources. (South Sudan experience strongly preferred)
