DUTY STATION: Kapoeta South
REPORTS TO: Cholera Response Supervisor
STATUS: Full Time
Duration: Three (3) Months.

COUNTRY PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The overall objective of the ARC South Sudan program is to assist the South Sudanese to respond and react to community needs. To achieve this objective, ARC implements a multi-sectoral program that includes primary health care, tertiary care, Nutrition, WASH and Gender based violence prevention and response activities. ARC currently works closely with the County Health Departments in large scale county wide health and nutrition programming. ARCs GBV programming is expanding its outreach mechanisms and introducing innovative new initiatives. ARC has program activities in Central and Eastern Equatoria, Northern Bahr Gazal, and Upper Nile.

PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The CTC/U supervisor shall be part of team for Cholera response in the greater Kapoeta South and East areas ensuring the delivery of quality patient care for acute watery diarrhea and related emergency care with MOH-RSS, WHO guidelines and universal precautions. He/She will be in charge of the cholera treatment center/unit established. He/she will also participate in prevention and control of acute watery diarrheal disease.

MAJOR AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY PRIMARY DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

Roles and responsibilities

- Oversee patient care at the CTC/U.
- Provision of patient care in Cholera treatment center (CTC) and Cholera treatment unit (CTU).
- Using isolation precautions in handling suspected cases of Cholera
- Patients feeding materials or utensils are kept fully for him
- Body fluid should be discarded with caution
- Specimens should be labeled "cholera" to protect laboratory personnel
- Strict personal hygiene



- Control of Population Movement
- Work on duty night, weekends and public holiday.
- May be assigned with the mobile team for case managements, prevention and control of disease.
- Admit patients to the wards; use the nursing process in patients' management, assessment, nursing diagnosis, set goal/ expected outcome, determine the nursing intervention, execute the nursing intervention and then evaluate; conduct nursing rounds; taking part in doctors round; write and give ward reports
- Giving support and advice on the daily care of the patients.
- Providing advice and guidance on prevention of the disease
- Educate patients and relatives on causes, treatment and prevention of acute water diarrheal diseases.
- Liaising with agencies and other health and social care professionals to ensure continuity of care
- Participating in the training and supervision of junior colleagues
- Ensure a clean working environment.
- Record patients on standard recording tools
- Performing other duties in the hospital/PHCC/PHCU as required

Qualifications and competences

- Diploma in Nursing from a recognized institution and bachelors of science degree in nursing will be added advantage
 - Minimum of 3 years' experience in patient care. Past experience working in CTC/U preferred.
 - Registered to practice with a recognized professional body
 - Experience working in emergency response is an advantage.
 - Excellent communication skills – English written, ability to communicate in Arabic & Toposa language is an added advantage
 - Ability to work well under pressure and in harsh environment
 - Proven ability to work cooperatively with others in a team environment
 - Good understanding of the political and cultural context of South Sudan
