AIM OF THE POSITION

Radio operator operates the ICRC's telecommunications equipment. He/she maintains radio contact and telecommunications between sites, Vehicles and people so that the delegation can follow field movement in accordance with its programme and with security rules.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operates all equipment for Voice (Tel, VHF, HF) and for Data communication (Lotus Notes)
- Provides guidance on the telecommunication transmission guidelines and coaches' drivers and field teams accordingly.
- Supports proactively information flow on security-related issues
- Selects most efficient mean of communication (inside and outside ICRC), taking in account format (electronic or paper), speed and price
- Keeps the ICT inventory of the Sub delegation for VHF; Mobile phones, Thurayas, and other ICT equipment up-to-date and liaises with JUB ICT department for maintenance needs
- Performs function checks on the Thurayas and Radios in the safe areas once a month
- Informs IT Technician, System Engineer and the administrator immediately about malfunctioning
- Registers and treat incoming and outgoing information confidentially, rapidly and with accuracy.
- Distributes urgent and private messages directly to the concerned persons
- Answers the phone on an ICRC representation way, updates regular the list of useful telephone numbers
- Assures that field trip form is correct filled and it is approved and informs concerned (Sub)delegations about planned trip and dvises delegates about routing, contacts, appropriate channels.
- Ensures contacts on departure, check points, borders and arrival and registers all contacts in Logbook / Field Mobile Log Database.
- Follows the movement of mobiles, makes sure that all mobiles arrive at their destination and waits until confirmation comes.
- Contact concerned persons / authorities in case of necessity
- Receives calls on external lines and distributing them to internal extensions
- Maintains switchboard equipment clean and well-functioning

- Respects international and national radio procedures when contacting other stations.
- · Uses radios only for professional reasons.
- Keeps messages short, clear (very understandable)
- Disciplined when listening and when starting to transmit.
- Follows the clearness of the channels, switches channel if necessary, not without prior information
- · Checks content of messages and necessary signatures.
- Assures correct numbering of outgoing messages (Wave Mail messages, Fax)
- Makes sure that all messages arrive at their destination and all messages for the sub-delegation are well received (weekly or immediate check-up with other delegations)
- Keeps record and tracks of Sat-phones, portable radios or other IT equipment based in the radioroom.
- Ensure Radio operation permanence in the respective s-delegation or in another s-delegation/office, when requested.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Vocational training in electronics, telecommunication, IT or similar field
- 2-4 years of experience in electronics, information technology, telecommunication or similar position
- · Conversational in English and Arabic
- Excellent knowledge of the geographically assigned environment
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning; Planning, Organization & Assessment; Communication (Ability to express views and ideas); Analysis & Synthesis
