Job Purpose: To reduce the mortality and morbidity of the vulnerable refugee population within Yusuf Batil camp.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide consultations with diagnosis and treatment of illnesses based on the guidelines of South Sudan and focusing on IEHC
- Prescribe medications and instruct patients on correct usage
- Provide patient education and instruct on prevention methods for illness, proper nutrition, and hygiene
- Compile weekly and monthly reports required by the Ministry of Health as well as UNHCR and provide to Medair Health Manager or Team Leader
- Compile weekly and monthly reports required by the Ministry of Health as well as UNHCR and provide to Medair Health Manager or Team Leader
- Provide day to day clinic management, line manage clinic staff, and provide training for CHWs and nurses
- Contribute to regular clinic team meetings and health and nutrition team meetings
- Assume the responsibility of Clinical Officer in Charge role as requested by Health Manager in order to cover absences
- Rotate to various clinical sites per operational needs
- Ensure all patients are treated based on the Guidelines of the Ministry of Health and the IEHC guidelines
- Support completion of monthly MoH quality supervision checks of the clinic and disseminate results within clinic team as well as the clinic improvement plan for next quarter
- Assist dispenser and other clinic staff in preparing stock requests as needed
