1. Action Africa Help International is an African-led, international non-governmental organisation, based in Nairobi, Kenya. With Country Programmes in South Sudan, Uganda, Zambia, Somalia, and Kenya, AAH-I has over 20 years' experience working with livelihood-challenged communities to sustainably improve their well-being and standard of living. With Support from Bread for The World, AAH South Sudan is implementing a Regional Primary Health Care Program in Ibba, Yei, Mundri-West, Morobo and Maridi counties of Central and Western Equatoria states. In addition, AAH extends its support in the training of human resource for Health.
2. Maridi School of Nursing and Midwifery (MSNM) initially Maridi Nurse Training School (MNTS) is a government institution supported by Action Africa Help International. The school has been operational since 1992 with funding largely from BftW/EED. From 1994, more than 947 health workers have graduated in various cadres; these includes lower (e.g. CHWs and MCHWs) and middle-level (e.g. nurses and midwives) health workers. The institute has strived to address the severe shortage of qualified health workers in South Sudan where prolonged conflict has adversely affected the health system. Currently, the school has been upgraded, offering diploma in Nursing and Midwifery in line with the Curriculum from the Ministry of Health.
3. With Technical Assistance of the Consultant, the Grant Recipient intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under contract for mid-term evaluation for the
