Wathab Engineer 1 **Based in Juba**

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead the team in charge of maintaining and operating all equipment and systems supporting the provision of technical services to the ICRC operated and/or supported hospital departments.
- Under the direct supervision of the Hospital Program Manager, and with the technical guidance of the WatHab pool manager, elaborate and implement a maintenance schedule.
- Contribute to the supervision of all infrastructure works implemented by the ICRC, in order to develop an intimate knowledge of their maintenance needs and operation best practices.
- Elaborate and supervise the implementation of a preventative maintenance schedule addressing (1) ICRC generators and electrical systems, (2) Juba Military Hospital water supply system, (3) ICRC operated sanitary facilities, (4) ICRC operated wastewater collection and treatment system, (5) ICRC operated medical facilities and buildings.; elaborate a standard list of repair works to be implemented, i.e. addressing water and current leakages, unblocking pipes, replacing faulty electrical equipment...
- Consolidate a list of equipment and tools necessary to implement the preventative maintenance schedule and standard repairs; under the supervision and guidance of ICRC Hospital Program Manager and in close collaboration with Juba Military Hospital (JMH) administration, identify a suitable place where to establish a workshop, and pilot the design and implementation of the workshop area.
- Carries out costing of projects and prepares BoQs. ensures works are implemented correctly, on time, and within budget; engages JMH Administration, medical staff and technical/functional bodies (infection control committee...) to explain and promote JMH maintenance activities, and secure their participation.
- Continuously assess the effectiveness of the maintenance process, and proactively suggest improvements to the Hospital Program Manager.
- Shares monthly financial forecast to the Hospital Program Manager; ensures payments of daily workers, suppliers and contractors;

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- University Degree in electrical engineering or similar.
- Additional training in water supply, sanitation, construction, engineering or any related technical field.
- 3-5 years of professional experience in a related activity; experience managing 1-3 technical support staff.
- Excellent command (spoken and written) of local language(s)
- Excellent command of (spoken and written) English and/or French
- Proficient in the use of drawing software if working in construction and hydraulic engineering.
- Proficient in use of AutoCAD, and MS project management suite or equivalent.
- Expert level in computer skills (including MSOffice and some CAD drawing and design software).
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning; Team Work, Planning, Organization & Assessment; Analysis & Synthesis; Responsibility & Autonomy.
- Familiarity with the standard norms and rules in construction, local techniques and requirements for construction.
- Driving license, succeeded in ICRC driving test.
- Experience in assessing, surveying, calculating and preparing estimates and technical drawings of buildings.
