HEALTH FIELD OFFICER III
Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Juba.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Contributes to assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of health programs
- Works with health facility staff to establish growth-monitoring, IEC (health education), and ORT corner (oral rehydration therapy) activities in ICRC-supported facilities and trains staff to run them
- Ensures malnourished children, pregnant and lactating women (PLW) are referred as needed to existing nutrition programmes on the field or in case no nutrition actor is present implements treatment for malnourished children and PLW.
- Timely collection and entering of statistics in the PHC Medical Activity Database (MAD), analysis of the same, and prompt submission of narrative reports to the Deputy Health Coordinator
- Networks and maintains contacts with State, local authorities and other humanitarian organizations, National Security, RRC and community leaders
- Provides information and gives advice to the health team regarding cultural and socio-economic issues
- Monitors the use of medical/pharmaceutical stocks by submitting regular monthly stock inventory and accurate consumption records
- Prepares requisition orders based on established "impress" system, ensures timely delivery to the health facilities, and issues donation certificates
- Monitors, reports and follows all suspected or confirmed outbreaks including but not limited to malnutrition and nutritional crises and disease outbreak especially of vaccine preventable diseases
- Develops and implements in collaboration with the field delegate of the HoO a comprehensive plan for First-Aid (FA) trainings, working with other weapon bearers (WB) and arms carriers to raise the profile of ICRC and identify priority groups for FA training
- Requests training materials and FA kits, ensuring donation certificates are completed and signed by all concerned; Independently conducts FA trainings to WB; actively participates in compiling information, including monthly statistics from FA activities;

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Medical professional background (Clinical Officer or Registered Nurse) with South Sudan registration and public health experience.
- At least 5 years' experience in humanitarian health programming, with thorough knowledge of the South Sudan Health System.
- Knowledge of EPI, Maternal-Child Health, tropical diseases, communicable and non-communicable diseases, first aid, gynaecology and obstetrics is desirable.
- Excellent analytical skills.
- Good command of both written and spoken English and of Arabic. Bari would be an asset.
- Computer proficiency in Microsoft Office (Excel, Word, etc.).
- Knowledge of Equatorias and surrounding areas.
