OVERALL DESCRIPTION

General Description of the Program

GOAL has been delivering both humanitarian and development programmes in South Sudan since 1985, with emergency health activities as a key intervention portfolio. In the wake of the EVD outbreak in neighbouring DRC, South Sudan is on high alert with the imminent risk of a regional spread of the diseases across the region. GOAL together with other stakeholders and partners actively engaged in supporting preparedness and early response strategies to mitigate risk to the spread of EVD into the Country. In this aspect, GOAL will be working in a consortium partnership with ALIMA and CONCERN Worldwide to support the Ministry of Health in strengthening capacities of the Rapid Response Mechanism at both the National and State levels, to mitigate the imminent risk of the EVD virus and other deadly haemorrhagic diseases across South Sudan.

As such, GOAL is seeking a dynamic individual to join this exciting and challenging position. The incumbent will be seconded to the MOH, Public Health Emergency Operations centre in Juba, and will be required to spend 70% of their time working in close coordination with the National Rapid Response Unit at the centre, and might require adhoc deployment travel in evolving circumstances outside of the designated base.

General Description of the Role

The Public Health Promotion Manager will be involved in the day to day management and analysis of health surveillance data of early warning systems in collaboration with the Rapid Response Teams, In addition, support related coordination efforts with partners and stakeholder working in health Risk Communication, Social Mobilization, and Community engagement sector. The incumbent is required to have a Health inclined background, public health or a related discipline, knowledgeable of the project management cycle, report writing, and good interpersonal skills

The position will require regular engagement with stakeholders with health related activities; various MOH departments, health cluster partners, and risk communication Technical Working group coordination forums i.e. both scheduled coordination meetings, and at time deployments to emerging missions

The position will support a process of strengthening capacities, working with personnel outside of the normal organizations management jurisdiction, with an aim of sharing, enhancing and imparting knowledge and skills based competencies.

He/she will be expected to actively be involved in supporting needs based training designs and execution process as they evolve



The project is funded through a consortium, and will require close working relations with all partners in the partnership

Key Duties

In collaboration with the consortium partners, work towards achieving the overall project objective through a process as follows;

- In collaboration with the EVD project coordinator (GOAL) and consortium partners, follow through on the work plans developed to ensure GOAL sectorial expertise in Risk Communication, Social Mobilization, and Community engagement aspects is adequately captured in the implementation process
- Engage and actively participate in GOALs sector specific coordination forums, Risk Communication, Social Mobilization and Community Engagement technical working group
- As a key member of the consortium support unit, closely work with GOAL EVD coordinator to assist the National Rapid Response Team in developing strategic projections and action plans, prioritize training needs on RCMCE, and deploy as need be to support National Rapid Response Teams cascaded the process at State levels
- Support the National Rapid Response Team in managing and analysing public health risk data, with a clear pathway to disseminating information across health partners and stakeholders involved emergency health.
- Support a process for dynamic partnerships and collaboration of the National Rapid Response Team with partners and stakeholder in public health response i.e. the process of partner mapping, regularly maintain and update key contact lists
- In collaboration with the consortium partners, jointly conduct routine (quarterly) monitoring and evaluation exercises using the commonly agreed tools i.e. Indicator performance tracking table (IPTT)
- In collaboration with consortium staff, ensure appropriate filing system is maintained at the National Rapid Response Team office at all times
- Ensure weekly context analysis reports are developed and shared with the Consortium lead at all times
- Incumbent will be a key member of the Rapid Response Mechanism, and can deploy at short notice (72 hours) to support an alert investigation

Requirements (Person Specification)

- Qualifications: Msc/Degree in Public Health or any other health inclined discipline, with not less than 2 years post qualification experience
- At least two years previous experience with an international agency in humanitarian/development programmes in a health-related position.
- Excellent interpersonal, motivational and staff management skills.
- Problem solving skills and approach will be essential, with facilitation and training skills an added advantage
- Strong analytical skills including collection, analysis, reporting, and applying of programme data.
- Experience in proposal and report writing.
- Experience in liaising with government officials, communities and other local partners, donors and other international agencies.
- Emergency response experience would be an advantage.
- Ability and willingness to deploy for short missions as may arise
- Incumbent will be required to sign and abide by GOALs safeguarding and code of conduct policies and guidelines

The job description is not exhaustive and might require role to change abruptly, or additional responsibilities to suite an unprecedented circumstance
