Job Title: Psychosocial Counsellor

He/she will work under the overall leadership of the PHC Coordinator in Maridi Office.

Job Summary: The overall purpose of this position is to provide support to the implementation of Community Psychosocial interventions on the PHC program, including; establishing the community based structure and referral systems and providing psychosocial counseling at Maridi Hospital.

Summary of Duties & Responsibilities

- Provide leadership in the implementation of psychosocial services in the communities in the Project area as guided by the project objectives, logical framework and work plan; and guided by the Health Policies.
- Coordinate the conducting of baseline assessment with other stakeholders and establishment of the M&E systems for the psychosocial interventions.
- Facilitate effective linkages within thematic groups and overall community linkages.
- Ensure smooth operations and coordination of psychosocial activities with liaison with the Boma Health Teams/committees.

- In liaison with Payam and Boma based local authorities, organize psychosocial integrated outreach activities and raising awareness on the health related issue that promote participation of communities and involvement in effort to improve maternal and child health.
- Ensure having clear referral structure for psychosocial cases, linkage and coordination between Health promoters, BHT/C and health facilities in the catchment areas.
- Co-ordinate, track progress, review results and addresses psychosocial challenges.
- Compile and submit weekly, monthly, quarterly and other reports on psychosocial activities required by the project.

- Diploma in health sciences i.e. Nursing/Public Health with formal training in psychiatry
- Previous experience in implementation of community psychosocial Programs
- Three years of progressively responsible professional work experience in psychosocial programs.
- Knowledge/experience in field-based project management, training of health workers at facility level in psychosocial care.
- Good communication skills i.e. good command of English language both written; and spoken; local languages and Arabic
- Good writing and reporting skills
