Job Purpose:

Contribute to the implementation, management, and supervision of Medair's WASH Emergency Response Programme.

Key Responsibilities

- To implement Hygiene promotion activities in the field by training hygiene promoters, conduction hygiene
 promotion messages house to house and in public palaces, conducting mobilization campaign, and implementing
 creative ways for communicating hygiene messages to communities.
- Act as a focal point for Medair ERT WASH team in field locations, taking responsibility for the security of the team and communication with Juba.
- Support WASH Technicians in the implementation of interventions and ensure community engagement in Medair WASH ERT interventions.
- Plan and execute hygiene promotion activities for field locations leading towards behaviour change among the beneficiaries. Apply SPHERE standards and protection mainstreaming principles at any stage and use recommended methodology according to international standards.
- Participate in the planning and implementation of WASH needs assessments amongst targeted communities.
- Refer to the WASH Pm before making any commitment on behalf of Medair whether verbal or written.
- Assist and advise the community in the selection and training of hygiene promoters, water & sanitation
 committees and water system operators, technicians and attendants. Where necessary hire, monitor and
 manage these personnel in the field.
- Manage stocks and supplies of HHP materials whilst in the field and provide logistical support to the teams in the field.
- Work alongside Medair Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) staff to establish tracking and reporting mechanisms for Medair WASH ERT Interventions
