Theatre Attendant helps with surgical procedures under the supervision of surgeons, ensures surgical instruments are clean before, during and after the surgery.

1.	<p>Prepare patients and tools for operation: Identifying patient service requirement by establishing personal rapport with patients and other health practitioners in charge of patient care management so as to understand services requirement; and preparing patient following established procedures for patient care and safety:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coordinate and prepare surgical equipments specific to the daily required surgical list • Prepares surgical room by washing and sterilizing all surgical instruments and equipments using special cleaners known as germicides. • Ensures that operating rooms are kept clean and tidy at all times. • Prepares patients for surgery by washing, shaving and disinfecting incision sites. • The theatre attendant scrubs, gloves, masks and gowns the surgical team.

2.	<p>Support during Surgery: The theatre attendant will provide wide range of support to the surgical team following established protocols including but not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He/ She supports the surgical team by passing surgical instruments to the surgeons when required. • cut sutures apply dressing and prepares specimens to the respective laboratory for testing. • Prepares the sterilised clothes for the surgeons. • Assist in patient care in the theatre
