**TERRE DES HOMMES**

Terre des hommes (Tdh) is a non-profit, non-political and non religious humanitarian NGO. Its objective is to steadily improve the conditions of the most vulnerable children worldwide. Tdh is implementing humanitarian activities in South Sudan since 2014, supporting population with Food Security, WaSH in schools and Child Protection in Yei River State and in Juba.

CHILD PROTECTION

Tdh is a leading Child Protection Agency. Tdh highlights the importance of protecting children among its programs in accordance with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) and in the best interest of the child.

FSL PROJECT

The Food Security & Livelihood project will be implemented in Yei from January 2019 and will include three components: Farming Support (seeds and tools distribution), Cash for Work and Restocking of Livestock. The overall aim of the project is to contribute to the restoration of productive agricultural inputs for the crisis affected communities in Yei town.

GENERAL OBJECTIVE

Under the supervision of the food security and livelihood Monitor, the Food security and livelihood outreach worker is responsible to provide assistance in, and assume responsibility for, the implementation the cash for work and farming activities and for ensuring proper coordination with the community and State and County representatives.

SUPERVISION

RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS**1. Implementation and monitoring of the Cash for Work activity**

- In collaboration with the relevant stakeholders and communities, actively participate in the identification, registration, and verifications of beneficiaries for seeds distribution according to Tdh vulnerability criterion.
- Ensure basic information on target beneficiaries is collected and recorded and shared with FSL Monitor in a timely manner.
- Ensure and monitor the distribution of activities-related kits.
- Ensure participants' satisfaction and mobilization through regular outreach following-up.

**2. Collaboration in the Communities**

- Actively participate to the good collaboration with local Leaders.
- Explain the project and Tdh FSL programs to the community members.
- Act as a liaison with the local population and Authorities in order to identify the needs, grievances and major events that could have potential consequences for Tdh activity.
- Ensure that Beneficiaries and local populations both understand the project goals and actively participate in their implementation.
- Organize sensitizations for the beneficiaries or community's members according to the identified need.

3. Communication and representation of Tdh

- Pass on any information/issues or problems to his/her direct and/or indirect supervisor concerning his/her task, Tdh programs, or safety aspects.
- Represent Tdh at anytime and anywhere when he/she is on duty.

4. Team working

- Participate in all the team meetings.
- Support any FSL activities when it is required (for surveys, distribution, etc.)

5. Reporting

- Collect data, pictures and information from the field and pass the information to the FSL Monitor
- Collect complaint feedback and circulate it among the team.

The tasks and responsibilities defined in this job description are not exhaustive and can evolve depending on the project needs. The employee could be requested to perform other tasks as his/her Line Manager may judge necessary.
