Purpose of the position:

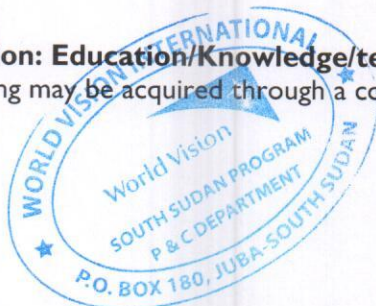
The EVD Point of Entry Screening Officer will be responsible for the assessment of all arriving travelers at the screening points managed by WVSS for signs and symptoms of EVD. (Mixed primary and secondary screening)

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To measure travelers temperature, using a non-contact infra-Red thermometer
- To look for signs of illness and check for symptoms of Ebola and to run the questionnaire on the Traveler Public Health Declaration Forms (IHR 2005) to identify travelers that may have been exposed to the disease
- Based on findings from above temperature measurement, visual observation and interview, to decide if the travelers can be released from screening to continue their journey or if they should be referred for quarantine at isolation facilities if suspected
- To raise alert of suspected EVD case using the 6666 hotline and/or establish arrangement for referral of suspected EVD case for further medical support services that may be required
- To take the opportunity of the screening process to systematically offer information around EVD to travelers so that they have better understanding of the disease and what to do should they develop symptoms; hand out EVD education materials to screened travelers
- To ensure recommended infection prevention and control and personal protection measures at the point of entry (handwashing, disinfection, waste disposal) are applied
- To manage data related to screening activities at the Point of Entry: tallying entry, and reporting to the EVD Preparedness Coordinator as required.

Qualification: Education/Knowledge/technical skills & experience required:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:



- Basic public health (Clinical Officer) with knowledge of EVD case definition.
- Have received training on point of entry screening protocol.
- Have received training on personal protection or infection prevention and control.
- Flexible and available 24/7.
- Experience in Health in Emergencies is an added advantage.

HOW TO APPLY

Interested candidates who meet the above criteria should submit their applications which shall include a cover letter, together with an updated CV with at least three referees with their telephone and email contacts.
