# ERT Health Manager Emergency Response Team

**Job Purpose:** To be deployed in any of the states of South Sudan, often working in remote locations to respond to emergency health needs, including disease outbreaks, nutrition emergencies and population displacement.

### A. Key Responsibilities

#### I. Intervention implementation:

- Participate health assessments in areas of new displacement or potential disease outbreak.
- Be part of appropriate responses, including vaccination campaigns, ICCM set up, outbreak case management and new PHC set up clinics.
- Train ICCM distributors/clinic staff/vaccination staff/registrars, on appropriate response methods
- Supervise primary healthcare services/outbreak disease management provided following MoH treatment guidelines
- Ensure health education messages including IYCF, health-seeking behaviour, hygiene, EPI, outbreak disease prevention are communicated in PHC sites
- Discuss with Project Manager and/or Medical Manager referrals and technical issues related to management e.g. diagnosis, treatment, etc.
- Responsible for medical administration and report writing at clinic level (DHIS, IDSR) in addition to drafting ERT assessment and intervention reports

#### II. Staff Management:

- Line manage locally recruited staff working in the health centres
- Act as team leader when requested

#### III. Quality Management:

- Prioritise high-quality services, maintaining accurate and upto date knowledge of relevant guidelines in implementation, monitoring and reporting

#### IV. Logistics:

- Be responsible for field stock management and team finances when needed.
- Help to keep a cold chain/vaccine management on vaccination campaigns
