### AIM OF THE POSITION

Drives heavy vehicles (Boats) transports people and/or material as per instructions

### Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Drives heavy vehicles (Trucks) and light vehicles and transports people and/or material as per instructions
- Over sees the Loading and unloading of the boat as necessary and ensures that the goods are loaded safely. Properly delivers cargo as requested and to obtains transport documents for all cargo transported
- Ensures that passengers and cargo on board have all the necessary authorizations and documents available
- Controls attributed boat and avoid misuse.
- Follows all internal ICRC and legal security and safety rules and regulations.
- Establishes and communicates through VHF/HF Radio systems as and when required.
- Is sensitive to security and river safety situation, and reports any danger or incident to the Team Leader during the trips, and to his supervisor back at the delegation.
- Respects the local river traffic laws and is presenting the institution on the River in a proper manner
- Avoids operating on hazardous stretch along the river.
- Carries out the daily boat condition checks and inventory of equipment and accessories of the assigned boat as per instructions.
- Maintains the boat equipment and reports immediately any need for replacement.
- Ensures permanent cleanliness of the boats
- Carries out daily maintenance and minor repair as and when required
- Checks on a daily basis the general working and body conditions of the boat and its accessories.
- Maintains and carries out basic service of the boat during trips.
- Performs trip checks as per checklist and ensures timely preparation of the boat as per standards.
- Reports technical boat defects and or/missing equipment immediately to the Dispatcher.
- Maintains the logbook or electronic logbook of the boat.

- Pays specific attention and assures refueling and recording in the log book
- Reports changes in security or river safety situations immediately to his superior
- Reports any incident / accident immediately and ensures the timely establishment and submission of the relevant report.
- Drives in such a way that the fuel consumption is minimized (select proper gear etc.)
- Checks boat condition (ensure clean Air & Fuel-filter etc.) to minimize pollution.
- Ensures refueling of the boat without spilling fuel or oil into the river

#### **Education and professional qualifications**

- Minimum Secondary school certificate
- Driving license with clean record
- Minimum 6 years' experience piloting large river boats
- Previous experience captaining a boat
- Ability to hold simple conversations in English
- Capacity to organize crew and cargo
- Capacity to operate various types of watercraft (multi-engine, propeller driven, water-jet, in-board, out-board engine etc.)
- Knowledge of HF, VHF radio's and general radio procedures
- Mechanical aptitude – ability to carry out or direct others to make basic maintenance and repairs
