DRIVER TRAINING

Our driver training is delivered from Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) UK in conjunction with the Driving Standards Authority (DSA) UK. Our driving instructor has a wealth of experience in driver training, fleet maintenance and management he has taught a multitude of students from beginners to advanced drivers, including security drivers, foreign military, Embassies, NGO's and UN Agencies with great success. He has gained over 25 years of progressive training during 24 years of British Military service and 8 years within the private sector. Students will learn not only the mechanics of the 4x4 driver training and mechanical operation, but traction demands, weight shift changes and proper gear selection. Practical exercises include proper off-road braking, acceleration, obstacle avoidance, emergency reactions and recovery techniques, including improvised techniques. The culmination of training is an unknown terrain driving exercise that combines all elements of training.

Driver Basic Mechanics – this course will explain the importance of carrying out pre-checks before driving the vehicle. Identifying a problem at this stage will save you time and money on recovery costs. Drivers will be taught how to check their vehicles during halt or fuelling stops. Post driving checks will explain the importance of leaving the vehicle in such condition that it is ready for the next deployment or task reducing delays.

Defensive Driver Training – This course is designed to go right back to basics, seating and hand position, steering and pedal control. Explaining the different kinds of braking systems and how the driver should use them.

Off Road Driving – Explaining in depth the four-wheel drive system and how all the component parts work together will enable the driver to fully understand and feel what the vehicle is doing, this will also prolong the life of component parts and tyres. Teaching the correct procedures for steep ascents and descents will ensure the safety of both the vehicle and all of its passengers.



Winching and self-recovery is a must for this type of environment.

Security Training – Security is a major concern during these unstable times, situation awareness and journey management are key areas for success. When things don't go how you planned and capture is imminent you will need to know all the do's and don'ts to survive.

NB: all above courses can be adopted for Armoured vehicles and can be restructured to suit your needs.
