Who we are

- Ensure daily coordination of the Child Survival Program implemented in the field locations, i.e. Yei and Juba.
- Liaise with sites field officers, field coordinator, to manage, develop professional skill set and provide oversight of capacity building for the Field Officers in each locations.
- Provide logistical and program oversight of daily activities of three Field Locations.
- Coordinate with the field officers and M&E team to confirm data collected at the field are analyzed and entered into DHIS data base.

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- Work closely with CHD Focal Persons to ensure restocking facilities are fully stocked with ACTs, Amoxicillin, ORS and Zinc.
- Liaison with CHD Focal Person on a regular basis to maintain relationship between PSI and the County Health Departments (CHD) as well as ensure and PHCC/U are maintaining an efficient supply chain.
- Represent ICCM Program Manager at the community level during community leaders' sensitization and mobilization meetings.
- Oversee the selection of new CBD and CBD supervisors in coordination with field officers, community leaders and CHDs.
- Monitor progress against targets, conduct regular meetings and progress reviews.
- In collaboration with ICCM Program Manager, develop and manage monthly activity budgets and workplan.
- Submit monthly reports to ICCM Manager.
- Monitor and track movement of commodities from Juba ware house to CHDs/field stores.
- Perform any other relevant duties as assigned by the Child Survival Program Manager.
