IMA World Health is seeking Lab Technician based in Pochalla Hospital. He/she will oversee and responsible for all laboratory service including accurate diagnosis and follow up all cases which need further diagnosis.

Essential Functions:

- Review and process orders for laboratory tests and procedures for patients
- Collect samples from patients
- Prepare specimen and samples
- Maintain quality contract of specialized tests as ordered by medical professionals
- Operate standard laboratory equipment and same specialized equipment
- Perform routine tests and some specialized tests as ordered professionals
- Follow and ensure strict safety procedures and safety checks
- Enter data from analysis of medical tests and clinical results into the register/computer.
- Set up clean and maintains laboratory equipment.
- Communicate to patients and laboratory information to clinical staff and patients in professional manner.
- Maintain quality results by running standards and controls, verifying equipment function through routine equipment maintenance and advanced trouble shooting; calibrating equipment utilizing approved testing procedures; monitoring quality control measures and protocols.
- Ensure the laboratory is well stocked and resources.
- Ensure clean working environment
- Remain on call at night for emergencies
- Performing other duties in the hospital as required.
