RESPONSIBILITIES:

Key Tasks and Duties:

- · Providing advice and support on technical WASH Component;
- Planning and implementation of hygiene promotion trainings and practical activities to IDPs primary schools' students and staff;
- Planning and implementation of water management trainings and supervision of water management committees work, in coordination with the relevant State organs;
- Organize, coordinate and supervise monthly soap distributions in IDP camps in Wau;
- Select and carry out suitable water quality controls;
- Supervise all WASH hardware constructions, ensure they are done in a technically sound and an environmental friendly way and provide suggestions for corrections/improvements;
- Ensure regular and timely documentation and reporting of WASH activities and collection of program indicators according to Malteser and donor standards
- Identify and monitor risks, constraints and escalating issues, and provide guidance in addressing the risks and challenges;
- Carry out (participate) in assessment and other relevant studies, individually, with colleagues or with partners;
- Perform any other duty assigned by the Program Manager.
