Job Description

Duties and Responsibilities

- Monitoring and providing appropriate clinical care to malnourished children admitted and outpatient.
- Assessing, classifying and treating malnourished children,
- Able to recognize and diagnose complications in children with malnutrition.
- Making notes and preparing paperwork, both as a legal record of treatment and for the benefit of other health professionals.
- Coordinate and discuss planned care with the patient and other team professionals as appropriate.
- Maintain effective interpersonal relationships with all staff and patients.
- Ensure that the patients and staff are kept fully informed of and understand all procedures and treatments to be undertaken. Informed consent will be obtained from patients in accordance to CUAMM/MOH policy.
- Provide advice to patients regarding healthy lifestyles and specific measures that may help patients avoid a recurrence of ill health and malnutrition
- Supervise the team working in the SC as well as support them.
- Any other duties assigned.
