Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Supports the Health Care in Detention (HCD) Delegate in the analysis and definition, planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of Healthcare in Detention program;
- Liaises and builds networks with the Health Directorate of the National Prisons Service of South Sudan (NPSSS), the Ministry of Health and other actors involved in prison health in order to facilitate communication on and coordination of activities that are aimed at ensuring more efficient access to healthcare in detention;
- Participates in the creation of the Technical Working Group on Healthcare in Detention and in the management of its activities;
- Implements Healthcare in detention programmes in Juba Central Prison (JCP);
- Through technical advice, coaching and training, material assistance and complementary actions, works with the health staff in JCP to improve access to healthcare;
- Conducts regular field visits to coach/mentor Healthcare in Detention FO in the implementation and monitoring of health in detention activities.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Medical professional background (Medical Officer) with South Sudan registration and public health experience.
- 3 - 5 years working experience with thorough knowledge of the South Sudan Health System
- Experience in first aid and nutrition.
- Advanced ability to converse in English and Arabic. Nuer or Dinka an asset.
- Knowledge of the authorities or other stakeholders, potential network of interlocutors.
- Expert level in computer skills
- Skilled in the following competencies: Networking & Communication; Adapting & Learning; Responsibility & Autonomy; Communication (ability to express views and ideas); Analysis & Synthesis.
- Good knowledge of the ICRC mandate, International Humanitarian Law (IHL), and of other humanitarian topics.
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment.
- Driving License; succeeded in ICRC Driving test.
