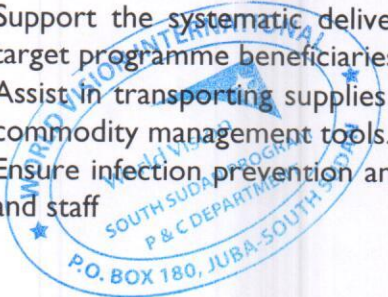
**Job Title: Nutrition Officer**  
**Reporting to: Nutrition Project Coordinator**  
**Location: Juba, South Sudan**

### **Purpose of the position:**

To take responsibility for successful implementation of nutrition project in the designated health facilities and outreach points through close collaboration with the MOH and facility health committees. The Nutrition officer will support implementation of nutrition interventions in the health facilities in close collaboration with the SMOH.

### **MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Co-ordinate and monitor the Nutrition interventions at facility level in close collaboration with the Ministry of Health staff and other partners in the area
- To ensure CMAM program reporting protocols are implemented according to the national guidelines (IMSAM) and reports submitted in time.
- Implement a recognized system of monitoring of beneficiaries to ensure that those targeted receive treatment rations and their outcomes are monitored to measure the impact of the programme to SPHERE standards.
- Monitor utilization of supplies for SFP/OTP/SC and ensure records are well kept.
- Conduct on job training for the CNVs and the nutrition assistants.
- Support the systematic delivery of Health, Hygiene and Nutrition education messages to the target programme beneficiaries and the entire community
- Assist in transporting supplies to all health facilities and ensure proper documentation in all the commodity management tools.
- Ensure infection prevention and control precautions are followed at all time by the beneficiaries and staff



- Assist in facilitating trainings when called upon by the nutrition coordinator/manager
- Support the Nutrition coordinator and Nutrition manager in preparation of weekly and monthly reports for all health facilities for continuous assessment of the effectiveness and the impact of the program

**Qualification: Education/Knowledge/technical skills & experience required:**

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Undergraduate/Diploma /certificate in nutrition and related discipline
- Three years Clinical officer training with experience in field of nutrition programming
- Registered/Enrolled Nurse with South Sudan training with 2/3 years CMAM/CTC field experience.
- Computer literate.
