WASH Technician - Renk



Job Purpose: Contribute to the implementation, management, and supervision of Medair's WASH Project in Northern Upper Nile State. Serve as technician for the planning and implementation of construction and rehabilitation of WASH structures, to the required standard

Key Responsibilities

Staff management

- Whenever necessary, support the WASH PM in local staff recruitment, and capacity building.
- Seek to resolve SWAT operators' issues that arise, raising them to the WASH PM if necessary.
- Conduct payments for casual labourers in an open and transparent way, in line with pre-approved work plans.
- Work alongside the BCC team to develop community training materials and ensure the use of participatory methodologies in project implementation.

Planning, execution and management of WASH structure construction or rehabilitation

- Implement the agreed activity plans as set out in project proposals, in liaison with the WASH PM.
- Work hands on alongside the community on the implementation of the project
- Draw up BOQs when necessary for systems to be constructed or rehabilitated.
- Oversee the technical execution of the projects including manual drilling and well installation
- Proactively plan ahead in terms of activities required to ensure the ongoing clean water provision in locations assigned.
- Ensure both Wonthow and Payuer SWATs are working properly, water quality data tracked & reported regularly, SWAT operators have the necessary knowledge and skill to treat water using alum and chlorine and conduct regular water quality testing.
- Ensure the quality construction of all water structures, ensuring good maintenance and sustainable processes are put in place.
- Collect and report all data needed during drilling such as soil logging and progress drilled each day to WASH PM
- Appropriately involve the beneficiary population in the projects.
- Give technical support to clinic water supply and waste management infrastructure related issue.

Logistics

- Provide assistance to the field logistician to maintain an accurate record of all equipment and material stocks for the WASH team.
- Support logistics staff in procuring items at the right cost and to the correct quality standard.
- Ensure careful use, regular servicing and appropriate replacement of all WASH equipment.
- Assist the Logistics Officers in maintaining accurate records of Renk WASH stock.
- Advise WASH PM on key procurement decisions for long-lead time and complex WASH items.

Quality management

- Ensure effective integration and mainstreaming of gender, protection and considerations for the elderly and disabled into the project.
- Ensure sectorial integration, learning, sharing and adoption of best practices as outlined in SPHERE guidelines, and Medair South Sudan guidelines to ensure quality of projects.
- Review and suggest recommendations for WASH activities and strategy to the PM and WASH Advisor

Communication

- Develop and maintain good working relationships amongst local staff.
- Submit verbal or written weekly reports and other requested internal reports to the WASH PM.
- Support the WASH PM with input to external reports.
- Ensure regular, open and honest communication, with the PM and WASH team on progress towards the project objectives, performance of contractors, challenges and questions.
- Develop and maintain good working relationships with the NGOs, counterparts, and other agencies working in the areas of project implementation.
- Attend meetings with local authorities on behalf of Medair.
- Refer to the WASH PM before making any commitment on behalf of Medair whether verbal or written.

Security Management

- Ensure the safety and security of team members & assets on sites of operation.
- Adhere to Medair security guidelines and ensure their employment at all intervention locations.
- Liaise with WASH PM and PC regarding any insecurity in programme areas
