### **Purpose of the position:**

To facilitate, Train and organize community based groups, community protection committees, children committees and community members in child protection, Peace building, peace education and to foster normalcy and stability in the community and help lay mechanism in the community to protect children.

### **Major Roles and Responsibilities:**

- Developing and implementing weekly and monthly work plan of protection activities
- Identifying and formation of Community Protection Committees and Children Committees in Project location (county or payams).
- Work with local government officials, CBOs, churches and community to strengthen child protection mechanisms
- Build Community protection committees and children committee's capacity to monitor and strengthen peace building and protection in the community.
- Create awareness among community members, school children, churches members and committees, organized forces on child rights and responsibilities towards the rights.
- Increase awareness and participation of the community in children community events and recreational programs.
- Actively participate in both Participatory and rapid needs assessment once called upon.
- In collaboration with the local authority, local churches, schools, CBOs, establish and support County protection committees and focused on the welfare of the child and building a culture of peace.



- Support the protection officer in Training WV staff and other agents in DO NO HARM /LCP, GBV and child protection.
- Support and facilitate protection mainstreaming in your location
- Representing World Vision at County and State level in coordination meeting, Peace conferences, peace mitigation meeting, and Child protection working group meeting and other functions once delegated.
- Compile and submit relevant weekly and monthly progressive reports as required of you.
- And any other duties that may be assigned or delegated to you in WVSS.

- At least a diploma in Social Studies or its equivalent.
- Good Understanding of community Mobilization
- Ability to organize and facilitate a workshop or a training
- Experience of working with children at least for two years
- Excellent communication skills, team work, self-esteem with ability to work under minimum supervision and stressful conditions.
- Someone who is able to display cultural, gender, religion sensitivity.
- Good understanding of Child Protection and Peace Building.
- Someone who is able and confident enough to engage positively with local authorities at County and Payam level.
- Ability to sing, play at least volley ball or football, organize sports activities, athletics are added advantages.
- Good understanding of Human Rights, child abuse and protection concerns.

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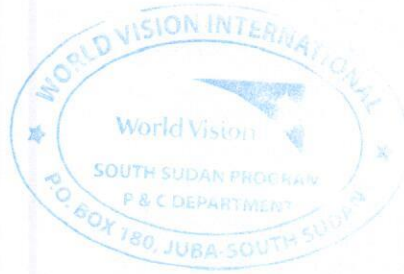

**Job title:** Food Monitor x 4  
**Reporting to:** IRRM Coordinator  
**Location:** Mobile Team, South Sudan  
**Availability:** As soon as possible

### **Purpose of the position:**

To provide end user monitoring, supervision and accurate documentation on all commodity distributions handled by WVSS.

### **Major Roles and Responsibilities:**

#### **Commodity Management and distribution**

- We are stewards through whom the donors channel assistance to the communities.
- Ensure that all commodities entrusted to World Vision arriving at distribution centers are **properly accounted for.**
- **Scrutinize all waybills** for commodities arriving at the distribution centers. Ensure that the commodities are of correct quantities and quality as manifested on the waybill. Immediately record all quantities delivered short (missing), quantities lost in transit and quantities damaged if any. All observations must be recorded immediately.
- Commodities must carefully be counted during off-loading.
- At the distribution center, commodities must be stacked in an organized manner, **by commodity type** to facilitate easy distribution.

#### **Beneficiary identification, selections and registration**



- Work to with the field coordinator, WFP, counterparts and the community to improve targeting efficiency.
- Using the approved beneficiary selection criteria, organize and participate in the registration and verification process
- Take active role in the registration and verification of beneficiaries to ensure that the process is fair
- Ensure that the most needy / vulnerable members of the community are properly targeted and protected. At all times ensure that the registers include more women beneficiaries.
- Ensure the registration process is well planned and documented

### **Distributions**

- Organize and supervise food and NFI distributions
- At the distribution center, commodities must be properly stacked on plastic sheeting.
- Ensure that the distribution center is properly organized and secured with ropes and crowd control measures put in place to ensure smooth distribution and flow of beneficiaries.
- Responsible to ensure that all necessary distribution equipment are available at the distributions center, including forms, ropes, banners, plastic sheets, measuring devices etc.
- Ensure an orderly and fair distribution of commodities using the approved ration sizes.
- Supervise the distribution of the food to the beneficiaries. Beneficiaries must sign or thumb-print against their names on the beneficiary lists as proof that they received their food rations.
- Supervise loading of food that is left over after distributions. Ensure that a waybill is prepared for food to be returned to the warehouse

### **Commodity Accounting.**

- Prepare daily distribution center visit reports and Food Monitors report. This is a MUST
- Ensure proper completion and safe return of all tally documents and beneficiary lists to the head office for safe storage.
- Ensure proper accounting of all quantities of commodities received and distributed at each center.
- Perform any other duty that may be assigned from time to time
