- 1) Develop criteria and establish mother to mother support group and nutrition committees.
- 2) Training and mentoring lead mother groups on IYCF key messages
- 3) To promote positive Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) Practices in the community.
- 4) Counselling mothers with special needs on matters related to breastfeeding and child care.
- 5) Designing IEC materials on nutrition and dissemination through various media.
- 6) Educate the child caregivers on the food preparation procedure through food demonstrations.
- 7) Promote appropriate household level labour/energy saving technologies e.g solar dryers for vegetable drying using local materials, energy cooking stoves and solar basket cookers.
