JOB ADVERTISEMENT Health Field Officer III-Midwife Based in Wau

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Wau.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Support and develop skills in management of all PHC activities in the Area of Responsibilities(AoR)
- Participates in assessments, planning, implementation, monitoring and reporting requirements.;
 Monitoring and evaluation of programs; availability of and compliance with MoH guidelines and protocols in the AoR; antenatal attendants receive LLITNs and clean delivery kits at the appropriate time and clear records are kept
- Children under 5, pregnant and lactating women are screened for malnutrition (MUAC) and referred to the nutrition program if needed; Pregnancy-related risks are identified and appropriate actions taken
- Rational use of drugs and medical supplies; Prepares requisition orders to be approved by his/her supervisor; monitors use of medical / pharmaceutical stocks: (monthly impress system, monitoring of consumption rates, inventory); Identifies and maintains regular contact with relevant interlocutors in the community: CHD, MoH, PHC, RH departments, and NGOs and is aware of health activities in areas of ICRC operations.
- Plans and conducts regular TBA meetings and trains them on recognition of danger signs, reporting, care
 of VSV and early referral; is part of the team that provides clinical care and psychosocial support for VSV
 in the area of responsibility, respecting confidentiality at all times.
- Training of local staff on preventive and curative care for Maternal and Child Health, including EPI, antenatal care, safe deliveries, post-natal care and post-abortion care, nutrition screening for children under 5 and pregnant and lactating women, Emergency Obstetric Care, care for Victims of Sexual Violence (VSV) and appropriate referrals; attends meetings that pertain to PHC including maternal and child health and VSV; Prepares Minutes of Meetings when appropriate; participates in collection of data from all AOR service areas as required, for the Medical Activity Database tool.

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- Qualification: Registered Nurse-Midwife.
- Experience in Primary Health Care programs (including safe-motherhood, nutrition, EPI, IEC)
- Good training and facilitation skills
- Experience in care for Victims of Sexual Violence (VSV) is an asset.
- Good level in computer skills including Excel:fluent in English and Arabic
- Previous experience with an international humanitarian organisation is an asset; ability to move freely in the entire Wau state
