AIM OF THE POSITION

The Education Field Officer is responsible for supporting operational activities relating to ICRC's Access to Education programme and strategy. He/she contributes to defining, implementing and monitoring ICRC Access to Education projects and activities in coordination with the structure's management, and to representing ICRC at a local and national level.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Implements and monitors various field activities, in accordance with objectives.
- Acts as a focal point for a given education project or portfolio and ensures documentation and monitoring is kept up to date.
- Analyses the security, socio-economic, cultural and political environment as relevant to the ICRC (regional/national/local level). Shares pertinent information with colleagues and reports any changes in the situation.
- Contributes to designing the orientation of the education-related projects and activities.
- Collects, compiles, translates/interprets information about the projects and contributes to written reporting.
- Participates in and holds internal and external meetings and develops and maintains contacts with high-level municipal education authorities, local Red Cross/Red Crescent Society branches, non-governmental organizations (local and international), Education Cluster partners and the population.
- Participates in administrative follow-up of field missions and assessments.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- University Degree in a relevant field; Education-related or EiE certification(s) an asset
- Fluent level of English and one other working language for South Sudan
- Proficiency in planning, organization and report writing
- Computer literacy, to include Microsoft Office Suite.
- Proficiency with data management software an asset
- 3-5 years overall professional experience, to include 2-3 years' experience in an education-related field (teacher, professor, school administrator, education project manager or programme officer with NGO or governmental structures).
- Experience designing and implementing teacher trainings.
