Team Leader – Communities Safety/Armed Violence Reductions (1) for DCA's South Sudan Office

DanChurchAid (DCA) is looking for an experienced **Team Leader** for Community Safeties and Armed Violence Reduction project. The position is a six (6) month position with the possibility of extension based on performance and donor funding. The position will based in the field/roving according to DanChurchAid's Humanitarian Mine Action Operation plan.

DCA is working with local partners in South Sudan to assist the poorest of the poor with a focus on protection, combating hunger, working for peace and conflict mitigation and the safe removal of explosive remnants of war (EWR).

In DCA we strive to secure high-quality standards for both our programme and support staff. The aim for our staff is to maintain a smooth running of the DCA Office with accountability, professionalism and staff welfare as a priority; creating an efficient, open and inspiring work environment for all.

The Team Leader – Community Safety and Armed Violence Reduction, will implement the Community Safety Planning activities by overseeing the day-to-day management of the CSP/AVR team, adhering to agreed standards and requirements. Furthermore, back the Safer Communities Advisor to ensure timely project delivery according to the implementation plan that specifically aim at Communities/CSP project building the capacities of communities to analyse risks and threats they face related to armed violence and identify, implement, monitor and evaluate their own risk-reducing strategies.

The responsibilities of the **Team Leader – Community Safety and Armed Violence Reduction** Include:

- Facilitation, preparation and implementation of community-based safety plans,
- Undertakes participatory development and consultations processes together with local communities,
- Conducting Community Liaison to ensure the informed consent and involvement of all parts of civil society in the safer community planning processes,
- Monitoring and report on challenges and progress of implementation of activities,
- Assisting in developing implementation plans and activities related to CSPs, SALW and AVR,



- Facilitating the community safety planning processes with the purpose of strengthening local community safety mechanisms as detailed in the DCA Standard Operation Plans (SOP),
- Conducting SALW Risk Education (RE) presentations when relevant as detailed in DanChurchAid's Standard Operation Procedures,
- Conducting needs assessment and assist in the identification of participant communities,
- Coordinating and oversee deployments of the CSP/AVR team,
- Do Quality Assurance of CSP/AVR activities ensuring a high level of beneficiary participation throughout the CSP project cycle,
- Ensuring activities and outputs are in conformity with the project plan and timeline,
- Recording, documenting and monitoring impact,
- Identifying training needs for the CSP/AVR team, and assist in training and refresher training of the team,
- Assisting in weekly and monthly reporting of project progress,
- Liaising with relevant government institutions, donors and other stakeholders,
- Preparing accurate and high-quality reports including beneficiary counts and other data as detailed in SOPs;
- Conducting participatory impact surveys/assessment before and after interventions when tasked.

We are looking for a colleague with the following qualifications:

- 3-years' experience with humanitarian and/or development work, preferably in the areas of Small Arms and Light Weapons awareness, Community Safety Planning and Armed Violence Reduction, protection, peace-building, conflict
- Very strong communication skills (oral and written English);
- A team player with an open, compassionate, humorous disposition;
- Flexible, patient and persistent personality;
- Good computer skills (Word, Excel, Power Point, Outlook, etc.);
- Candidate ready to embrace the four DanChurchAid values of **compassion**, **proactive**, **responsible**, **and respectful**.

DCA is an equal employer, so, we encourage women to apply and a South Sudanese will be preferred for the position.
