The M&E Officer will support the regular collation, validation and analysis of project required data from a variety of sources, including programmatic monitoring against project targets. S/he will participate in regular supervision visits at county, health facility and community levels, to verify reports submitted by health and community workers, and provide technical support around challenges identified. The M&E Officer will work closely to support the M&E officers at CHD and health facility level to compile and forward all routine Health Management Information Systems (HMIS) reports as required. These include DHIS1.4 Export File to HPF, Monthly Pharmaceutical Management Information System (PMIS) reports, Weekly IDSR reports and any other endorsed report by MOH or HPF. The data collated should allow disaggregation of results by location, age and sex. In addition, qualitative data on sustainability, cultural acceptability, equity and scalability should be collected as per agreed timelines. S/he will also work support the CHD to strengthen quality and use of routinely data to improve service delivery in the health sector.

Major Responsibilities

- M&E Strategy, Develop and oversee monitoring systems to track success of program implementation. Design research and evaluation efforts to assess the impact of HPF's programs. Improve data systems -collection, storage, use –to increase effectiveness and scalability of M&E systems
- Monitoring & Evaluation Implementation, Conduct and oversee analysis of data from day-to-day M&E activities as well as the ongoing HPF-funded impact evaluation of the SSUHA Experience program. Prepare high-quality reports for internal and external audiences. Build an organizational knowledge base through research and partnerships.
