JOB OPENING PHYSIOTHERAPIST

Based in Juba with frequent travel to ICRC field sites

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Juba.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assures the assessment of patient and the definition of the treatment plan
- Carries out the physiotherapy techniques according to the treatment plan.
- Recognizes problem / complications during the implementation of the treatment plan and informs accordingly
- Completes patient file and patient statistics; Participates in the final evaluations / discharge and ensure that instructions (including maintenance and use of appliances) are understood by patient / family
- Organizes a follow up in the treatment if objectives are not yet reached (Out Patient Department)
- Takes part in the maintenance and the inventory of physiotherapy equipment.
- Sets dates for patient appointments for physiotherapy treatment with the coordination of the Mobile physiotherapist
- Informs ICRC physiotherapist (or ICRC head nurse/ ICRC nurse in charge if ICRC physio is absent)
 of any problems that require follow up
- Performs patient assessment and physiotherapy to the patients (identified during the round with their colleagues, setting daily the priorities)
- Assures that all patients receive appropriate physiotherapy according to their disabilities
- Ensure that the patient will receive proper information about his further prosthesis/orthosis if needed and will fill up a referral form to the PRP
- Performs together with the Mobile physiotherapist, appropriate patient assessment, including the
 final assessment (with all the Mobile Surgical Team participating to the round) before the discharge
 Participates to the hospital rounds (with local staff & ICRC staff) as a full member of the Mobile
 Surgical Team; Participates to the weekly/general cleaning of the wards.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Diploma degree in Physiotherapy or equivalent experience;
- Preferably Registered Physiotherapist;
- 3-5 years' experience in Physical Rehabilitation Centre or Hospital work preferred;
- Written and spoken English, spoken Arabic;
- Intermediate computer knowledge;
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning, Team Work, Security Management,
 Planning, Organization & Assessment; Communication (Ability to express views and ideas).
