## **Organizational Background**

## Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

- Clean and disinfect the high risk area several times during the day (wards, pathways, latrines/showers) according to the procedures
- 2. Empty buckets of vomit and stool in the latrine, disinfect them and clean them with soap and water (use brush if necessary)
- 3. Clean and disinfect beds, buckets, plates, spoons, cups etc inside the high risk area
- 4. Clean and disinfect mats, clothes etc in the high risk area
- 5. Keep the high risk area cleaned and all the TSRU area cleaned
- Disinfect and pack dead bodies, move them to the mortuary and hand them over to the MoH/family members when they come to collect or view them (all according to the procedures)



- Be at spraying station at all times and instruct the people undressing and passers-by to respect the rules of undressing, spraying and hand washing;
- 8. Disinfect ambulances and other vehicles/places when needed;
- Move the used scrubs from the clothes baskets to the aundry area to be cleaned and hang it up to dry
- 10. Wash and hang scrubs, gumboots, aprons, goggles and gloves and other material to dry
- 11. Fold dried clothes and place in wardrobe
- 12. Chlorination of the water

## Personnel Qualifications (Special training/experience required) provide 6-7 requirements:

- 1. Two-year experience as a nurse aid in a hospital or communicable disease setting
- Reasonable communication skills in English (spoken and written) and Arabic (spoken)
- 3. Previous experience as a hygienist within a communicable disease setting desirable.
- Must be extremely flexible, willing to follow instructions and work within very strict guidelines.
- 5. Must have the ability to cope well in a stressful, highly charged environment.
- 6. Able to motivate and work with local staff effectively.
- 7. Implement any other duty requested by the direct supervisor.
