The ICRC is mandated to work in countries affected by armed conflict or other situations of violence. The ICRC is present in over 80 countries and has some 15,000 field staff.

**AIM OF THE POSITION**

EcoSec generalist 2 plans, implements and monitors the ICRC's economic security (EcoSec) programme in line with the country strategy and under the supervision and guidance of EcoSec Delegate in Wau, with frequent travel to the field in Wau sub-Delegation's area of responsibility. In the absence of the Delegate, s/he will report to the Deputy Coordinator for Resilience in Juba.

**Main Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Under the supervision of the EcoSec delegate, advises and supports EcoSec delegate with the design and implementation of agro, livestock and fisheries based small-scale livelihood support initiatives.
- Participates in emergency relief responses including assessment, implementation and monitoring of relief activities i.e. food, essential household items and fishing kits.
- Provides regular updates to EcoSec Delegate on FS related issues, particularly the impact of displacement and conflict on the livelihood, livestock, agriculture, fisheries, people's coping mechanisms with different gender perspectives in the program location.
- Collects nutrition information at the household level; uses their basic understanding of malnutrition to identify vulnerabilities and nutritional shortcomings.
- Ensures appropriate internal technical reporting.
- Prepares and presents assessment, distribution, post distribution monitoring and ad hoc technical reports in a professional and timely manner.
- Maintains a clear record/ trail of financial advances issued to the field officer updating reporting EcoSec Delegate and ensuring timely clearance of cash advance.
- Ensures that all FTRs (Field Trip Reports) are submitted to the EcoSec Delegate in a timely fashion.
- Represents ICRC in relief, agro, livestock-fisheries sector meetings in the respective program location.

- Additional vocational training in livelihoods, socio-economic development, nutrition is an asset.
- 3-5 years of experience in related field (Community resilience projects, Women empowerment projects, Food security and nutrition projects, Agro or animal husbandry projects, CFW projects, Voucher projects in emergency or crises context).
- Conversational Arabic and other local language is an advantage.
- Good command of written and spoken English- able to write comprehensive reports.
- Advanced level in computer skills (Excel and Word).
- Skilled in the following competencies: Analysis & Synthesis, Planning & Organizing, Adapting & Learning; Communication (ability to express and exchange views and ideas); Representing the ICRC; Teamwork.
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment.
- Readiness to spend more than 50% of the time in the field.
