Organizational background

IMA World Health is seeking a State Support Manager based in the above Ten States. S/he will ensure the successful operation of the Rapid Results Health Project II. State Support Managers will provide overall leadership for all partners in the assigned state and direct the strategic planning and decisions in building a decentralized county health system. Provide direction to the IMA County Support teams and represent them at the level of the SMOH and State Management Committee. This position will report directly to the Country Director.

Duties:

- Provide overall supervision and guidance to the other members of the state health management team including;
- Effectively utilize the full state health management team for maximum effectiveness in accomplishing the goals of providing the Basic Package of Health Services to as much of the population as possible within the financial limits of the grant;
- Establish and maintain effective project reporting, evaluation, and communication systems;
- Submit timely accurate and professional program reports that meet donor requirements;
- Manage grant/project budget within approved spending levels and ensure accurate and timely financial reports to donor and support office staff;
- Liaise with host government officials, project partners and other organizations as appropriate;
- Provide regular clear communications and reports to the IMA World Health South Sudan Representative with regards to progress of the project;
- Collaborate with efforts by IMA World Health in obtaining and implementing funding from other sources to expand health services;



- Ensure strong working relationships between the field office and HQ;
- Other relevant tasks as assigned.

The position requires a competent and experienced person with the following attributes:

- A degree in medicine from a recognized University and/or advanced training in public health, management, or a related discipline;
- Minimum 3-5 years of overall experience in the development of health service delivery and the management of health systems, emphasizing the revitalization of primary health care systems in rural areas and communities in developing countries;
- At least 3 years of experience in a program management position with responsibility for improving the results of public health services;
- At least 2 years of experience working with the MOH, local health staff, and local officials to implement improvements in health care in a post conflict environment;
- Fluency in English;
- Good communication and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work in a team;
- Ability to develop a good working relationship with local organizations, other program partners and counterparts in order to contribute at the highest level to project deliverables;
- Willingness to support IMA's mission;
