## **Duties & Responsibilities:**

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- Installing and configuring computer hardware operating systems and applications
- Monitoring and maintaining computer systems and networks
- Troubleshooting system, network problems, diagnosing and solving hardware or software faults
- Replacing parts as required
- Providing support, including procedural documentation and relevant reports
- Supporting the roll-out of new applications
- Setting up new users' accounts and profiles and dealing with password issues
- Responding within agreed time limits to call-outs
- Working continuously on a task until completion (or referral to third parties, if appropriate)
- Testing and evaluating new technology
- Conducting electrical safety checks on computer equipment
- Providing Support, including procedural documentation and relevant reports
- Maintaining record of Concern 's ICT Assets
- Developing staff IT capacity, skills and confidence in using common software packages and in communications equipment including HF and VHF radio
- Ensuring that Concern's IT policy and procedures are understood and that all staff adhere to them
