JOB OPENING FIELD OFFICER Based in Wau

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) is an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence that has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for a motivated person for the above position to be based in Wau (with frequent visits to the field).

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Assists the delegate in running of various field activities, and in support of the health, economic security, water and habitat, communications and cooperation departments.
- Under the supervision of the field delegate, supports the sub-delegation's response to conflict-related sexual violence through accompanying and referring victims, documenting protection cases and assisting with the development and implementation of livelihood activities for persons affected.
- Provides translation between English and Arabic in any situation with accuracy.
- Builds and maintains contacts with local authorities, local Red Cross Branches, communities, and local organizations under supervision of the field delegate.
- Drafts and contributes to written reports in relation to various field trips and other activities.
- Monitors developments relating to the humanitarian situation in the area of responsibility
- Advises the delegate in various fields such as politics, economy, culture, region, ethnic information's.
- Participates and conducts trainings and seminars in relation to ICRC target groups.

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- 'A' Level (higher/advanced higher-grade exam) or equivalent. Some college course work completed or an Associate degree is an asset.
- Additional vocational training in humanitarian area, socio-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or equivalent field.
- 3-5 years of experience in a humanitarian area, social-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or similar position.
- Experience working with victims of sexual violence an asset.
- Very good English and Arabic, other local languages an asset.
- Good level in computer skills.
- Skilled in the following competencies: representing the ICRC; adapting & learning; communication (ability to express and exchange views and ideas written and oral); analysis & synthesis.
- Ability to work independently, under the guidance of the field delegate.
- Good knowledge of ICRC mandate, IHL and of other humanitarian topics.
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment.
- Official driving license.
