Terre des Hommes Foundation (Tdh) is an international NGO focussed on Child Rights. To support the development of its project in Yei River state, Tdh is encouraging applications from South Sudanese nationals for the role of:

CHILD SAFETY VOLENTEER

Duty station: Yei

Contract duration: 3 months (with possibility to be renewed)

Starting Date: ASAP

Key Activities/Responsibilities

- Support the community leaders and community networks in setting up, organizing and implementing a safe daily school transportation system.
- Ensure that every child enrolled in school benefits from a safe transport to school every day.
- Ensure a safe and child friendly atmosphere during the transport time.
- Ensure the children participation and inputs are shared with the line manager.
- Be a positive role model and demonstrate conflict solving behaviours.
- Ensure daily registration of children at the commuting time.
- Identify cases of vulnerable children and refer to the Social Worker for support and referral.
- Inform the CPO of challenges faced in doing the work and if additional support is needed.
- Submit weekly reports and plans to the CPO.
- Ensure that children feel comfortable, safe and respected on their way to school.
- Participate in training workshops and thematic exercises on Child Protection and PSS support as per needs identified
- Perform other tasks as assigned by the line manager
