Training consultancy (and accompaniment) on fishing and fish processing techniques

As part of the the implementation of project: "Livelihood support towards early recovery & resilience - Mingkaman" funded by the Finnish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Finn Church Aid South Sudan (FCA) is looking to engage an experienced consultant who will be responsible for providing technical knowhow on fishing and fish processing techniques to project beneficiaries in Lakes State, Awerial County, Mingkaman. The Specific objective of the action is to strengthen the community's capacity to protect, restore and develop their livelihoods in sustainable ways.
