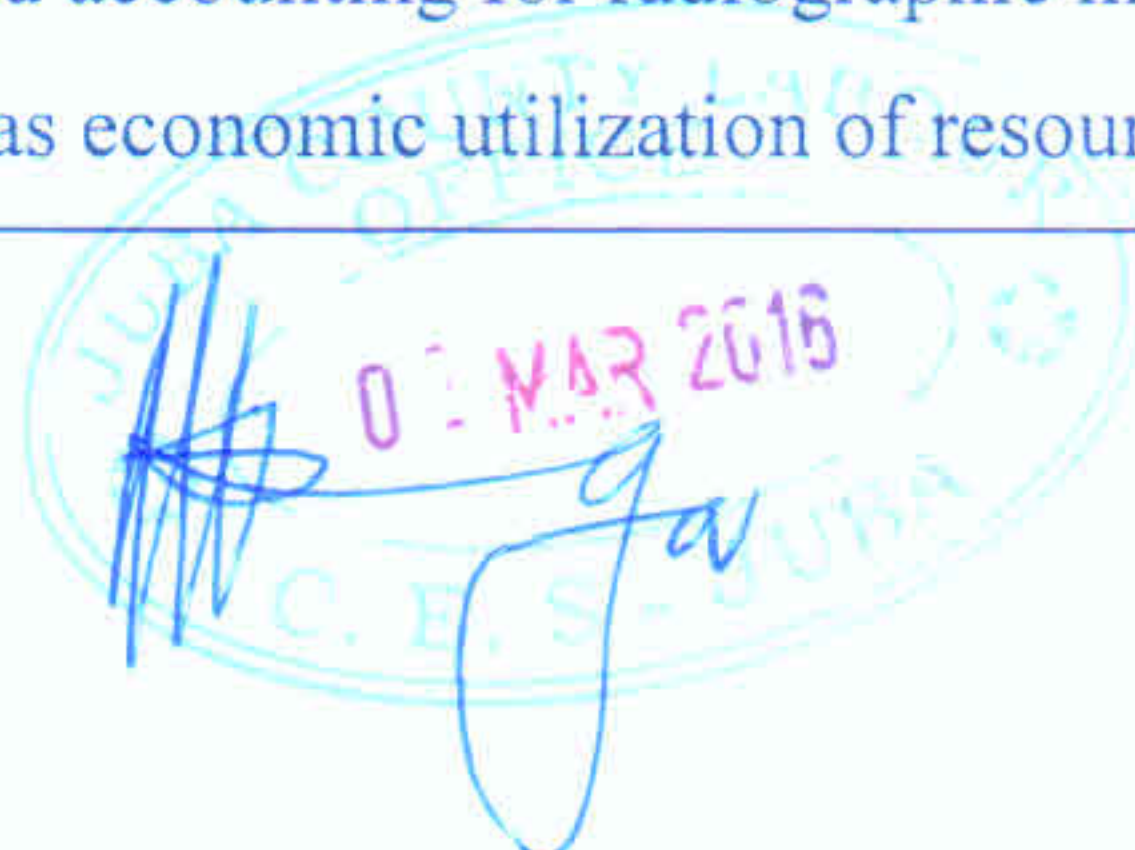
General Description of the Role
