### **AIM OF THE POSITION**

Movement Cooperation Officer 1 contributes to implementing their delegation's objectives for cooperation with the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement (the Movement) in line with the ICRC's Movement policies and in consultation with the local operating National Society (NS). S/he contributes to building a positive relationship between the ICRC and the National Society of the country where s/he is assigned.

### **Main Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Keeps regular contact, meeting and relationship with the SSRC staff and volunteers while respecting their channel of communication.
- In collaboration with the Head of Sub Delegation (HoSD) carries out regular field trips to the SSRC branches and is fully aware of their activities, ongoing project proposals, needs and challenges.
- Closely collaborates with Cooperation of National Society and Juba Cooperation on the financial transfer of program support funds to SSRC, and assist in the following up of the narrative / finance reporting.
- Develops a monitoring plan of the Cooperation activities and carries out joint monitoring of activities together with SSRC counterparts and provide timely feedback and follow ups.
- Compiles and updates information, prepares reports on Cooperation-related issues, contributes to required operation reports of the Sub Delegation (SD).
- Proposes creative projects that are in the interest of the SD and SSRC to the HoSD.

### **Minimum required knowledge & experience:**

- Vocational or university degree.
- Excellent command (spoken and written) of English and/or Arabic.
- Computer proficiency.
- Minimum 2–3 years' experience in a similar position.
- Previous experience working for the ICRC or another Movement component (NS and/or International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies) an asset.
- Skilled in the following competencies: Adapting & Learning; Team Work, Planning, Organization & Assessment; Analysis & Synthesis; Responsibility & Autonomy.
