RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ROVING PROTECTION PROGRMS MANAGER

IsraAID is looking for a Roving Protection Program Manager (RPPM) to support IsraAID's Programs in South Sudan which will include travel to project field sites. Responsibilities include:

(a) Development and Monitoring of Protection Response Strategy

- Strengthening the existing emergency response framework
- Identifying geographical areas of operations, sectors of operations and needs
- Developing response based on needs and monitoring activities based on set objectives (in initial proposal, logical framework and budget)
- Building relationships with community representatives, national partners and service
- Building relationships with other agencies operating in similar locations in protection and other sectors of activities (especially health sector)

(b) Coordination of Training for National Partners

Identifying emergency training needs (e.g. PFA, CMR, GBV, CM, MHPSS, CP etc.) together with the Case Manager

- Identifying and reviewing relevant training materials in coordination with the Case Manager, and Capacity Building and Partnership Director
- Facilitating training sessions when needed

- Monitor the partner progress and report this to the programs director and Capacity Building and Partnership Director.

(c) Coordination with external partners

- Representing IsraAID in Coordination Meetings (GBV SC, CPWG, PC, Urban Actor, GBV WG etc.)
- Meeting donors and other stakeholders, if needed

(d) Reporting

- Reporting on a weekly basis to programs coordinator (using weekly table of activity)
- Reporting to donor on a weekly basis
- Providing relevant data to program director in cooperation with Protection Manager
- Participating in weekly staff meetings
- Co-facilitate (with the other protection manager) the Social Workers group meeting on a weekly basis.

(e) Manage, supervise and guide the programs field staff members

- Provide guidance for ethical and professional issues
- Provide guidance and supervision for issues of time management, missions, objectives
- Monitor and evaluate the Social Workers daily activities.

REQUIREMENTS

The Manager must have the following qualifications and competencies.

- Should be a holder of degree or equivalent in Gender studies, Social Work, Psychology, NGO Management, Rural and community Studies or other relevant field of study preferred. Any other requirements relevant to the position.
- Experience working on protection, and knowledge of GBV & CP guidelines, Clear understanding of protection related programs and vast with all areas of protection (GBV/CP) and others.
- Strong communication and facilitation skills.
- Ability to train partner organization and service providers in various topics within protection setting.
- Minimum 4 years professional experience in implementing protection activities
- Ability to keep record and write sample and basic reports of activities would be an added advantage.
- Experience in project design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation process.
- Excellent communication, listening and observation skills, including ability to create trust, support, respect and interact with survivors of all ages, background and diversity.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality and respect at all time is essential.
- Understanding of and commitment to the following principle: cultural sensitivity, local ownership, sustainability, inclusiveness, local partnership, non-discriminatory, do-no-harm, and apolitical approach;
