Organizational background

Caritas Torit South Sudan is a Social Development Wing of the Catholic Diocese of Torit. Its overall goal is to build a peaceful and reconciled society through integral human development. Caritas Torit South Sudan covers all the 8 (Eight) Counties of Torit State and Kapoeta State (formerly Eastern Equatoria State) with 6 (Six) Health facilities which includes 2 (Two) Hospitals, 4 (Four) PHCCs and Health Post in Melijo IDP camp.

Misereor/KZE has been supporting CDOT, through Caritas Torit South Sudan (CTSS), for over a decade with funding to support basic health care services. The most recent program phase is aimed to complement interventions of previous assistance and to further strengthen quality and access to primary health care services through the diocesan network of 6 health facilities in 3 areas of the former Eastern Equatoria State (EES) of South Sudan. The program targets the most vulnerable individuals and populations groups and specifically aims to reduce mother and child mortality.

Foundation Caritas Luxembourg (FCL) and Caritas Torit have since 2006, a common background in collaboration in implementing projects especially in Eastern Equatoria State (EES) in the areas of Water, Hygiene and Sanitation, Education (Vocational Training inclusive), Women Empowerment, Justice and Peace, Community Empowerment, Capacity Building for Non-State Actors, Health and Food Security (Veterinary & Emergency inclusive). The recent successfully implemented food security program was in ISOHE, Ikwoto County, and Torit State which has served to strengthen the foundation for food security improvement in the project area.

In 2016 Caritas Torit solicited funds from Foundation Caritas Luxembourg (FCL) for "**rehabilitation of health and nutrition services in Kapoeta South- South Sudan**". The objective of the project is to contribute to reduction of morbidity and mortality due to chronic obstetric and surgical conditions and improve the general health status as well as the quality of life of the people of Kapoeta South County.



FOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

The overall objective is to provide safe, effective and curative health services, targeting the most important causes of common illnesses, morbidity and mortality rate among the target population.

The Registered Midwife shall undertake the following:

- Diagnosing, monitoring and examining women during pregnancy, delivery and postnatal.
- Identifying high risk pregnancies and making referral to the Clinical Officers.
- Provides, Supervises and monitors nursing care of patients in his/her ward.
- Together with Hospital in-charge, responsible for preparing requests for medicines and medical supplies from the drug store.
- Maintain infection control measures in the in-patient wards and responsible for the overall cleanliness of the unit as well as ensuring correct disinfection and sterilization of material, linen used for septic procedures and premises according to set protocols.
- Admit and discharge patients through the nursing process.
- Supervise the MCHW/TBAs activities at the Hospital
- Ensure that the ANC and PNC activities are offered at the Hospital.
- Assist in conducting deliveries at the Hospital.
- Conduct out pre-conceptual care, antenatal care, labour and delivery, post-partum care and neonatal care.
- Follow-up all new born babies properly from delivery and until discharge.
- Provide specific care for HIV pregnant women and ensure good quality of prevention of mother to child transmission and HIV counselling and testing activities for all pregnant mothers.
- Provide health education messages to in patients and counsel patients on drug compliance.
- Compile weekly, monthly, quarterly and annual report of patients' admission and referral cases.
- Lead and participate to Continuous Medical Education (CME) as presenters of topics and or learners and health education.
- Should be able to recognize obstetric emergencies and refer them promptly.
- Assist the clinical officer in the smooth running of the health activities at the Hospital.
- Regularly assess registrars to ensure that they are complete and updated.
- Any other duties assigned by the supervisors.
- Adhering to Professional Code of Conduct and Ethics.

Reporting:

- Participates in generation and compilation of weekly, monthly and quarterly reports from his or her departments.

Required Qualifications, Experience & Competencies

- Diploma in Midwifery, or related field.
- 2 years of relevant field work experience. Experience working in a reputable setup (NGO) is desirable
- Strong team player experience
- Fluency in English and knowledge of Local Arabic is an added advantage.
- Ability to work under pressure and multitask in unstable security environments.
- Culturally sensitive.
- Familiar with Health System in South Sudan
- Computer skills is an added advantage
