Purpose of the position:

The overall purpose of this position is to see SAM cases with medical complications admitted in the OTP and SAM/MAM admitted in the OTP and TSFP to administer requisite treatment to them; provide overall day-to-day leadership and management of the SC, OTP and TSFP at the IDPs and health facilities supported by the SSHF project; and to provide support to the target communities in addressing specific health activities meant to improve access to quality and equitable health services to the PHCC's catchment area populations including supporting training/capacity building of the PHCUs based staff and Community Resources persons, supervising and providing ongoing mentorship and support to the preventive services delivery persons.

Major Roles and Responsibilities of position

- See /attends to patients, administer requisite treatment and maintain up-to-date records of all transactions using provided registers and forms.
- Evaluation of child's medical and nutritional condition and ensure treatment for severe acute malnourished children with medical complication is in line with WHO management of SAM ; a manual for physicians and other senior health workers protocol.
- Provide leadership in the stabilisation centre, OTP by ensuring proper protocols are used in the management of nutrition patients.

- Effectively following the SC protocols for the medical care of the SAM cases with complications.
- Monitoring progress of children being treated at the SC OTPs and TSFP
- Ensure nutrition beneficiaries medical follow-up at stabilization centre as well as OTP and TSFP sites.
- Jointly with the Nutrition Manager, and other departments, plan implementation strategy and provide oversight of services in SC, TSFP and OTP locations.
- Assist with strengthening and set-up of SC, OTP, and SFPs layout, supply, guidelines and procedures, community Nutrition outreach services as needed;
- Ensure proper implementation of comprehensive Nutrition care in the SC, and OTPs with protocol and procedure in place.
- Supervise, motivate and train Nutrition nurses and nutrition assistants SC, OTP and TSFP.
- Network and coordinate with the relevant units in the hospital
- Conduct Ward rounds with the medical doctor
- Work closely with SC, Nutrition and IPD staff to ensure all SC protocols are understood and agreed and appropriate referrals take place to and from the OTP.
- Ensure the ongoing capacity building of Nutrition staff through support to direct supervisors in ensuring staff performance evaluations and individual development plans
- In liaison with County Coordinator and camp management authorities, County Secretary and other County authorities, organize community meetings and campaign forums that promote participation of communities and involvement in effort to improve maternal and child health; access to Health general services, and control of HIV&AIDS .
- Schedule and facilitate trainings of health staff, HHPs and Health committees for the targeted communities on nutrition.
- Strengthen the appropriate use of NIS, HMIS and consolidate the DHIMS while ensuring the availability of the HIMS in the health facilities in accordance with Basic Health Package of South Sudan.
- Support in surveillance of epidemic-prone diseases and reporting accordingly.
- Order supplies and maintain updated supply/order forms (Bin Cards) and Inventories for the OTP and stabilisation centre.
- Train and supervise home health promoters and outreach workers.
- Produce timely weekly and monthly nutrition reports.
- Conduct integrated nutrition outreaches in collaboration with the health team.
- Supervise ALL facility staff in the SC, OTP and TSFP
- Carry out additional responsibilities and projects as assigned, including administrative and planning functions.
- Conduct weekly supervisory visits to all the outpatient therapeutic program {OTP}

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognised institution;
- Thorough knowledge and skills of CMAM and related programs in rural situations;
- General understanding of health service delivery, especially those related to women and Children;

- At least 2 years' experience working OTP, TSFP, SC;
- Proven abilities in managing successful Primary Health Care Programmes in South Sudan;
- Proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision;
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines;
- Good time management and organizational skills: Able and willing to meet deadlines and agreed objectives
- Strong willingness to meet the customers' (clients) needs, while balancing the organization's needs and priorities
- Demonstrates Christ-centered life and work
- Fluency in English language and the local languages spoken is an added advantage.
