Health Field Officer-Ward Nurse (2 Positions) Based in Juba with frequent travels to field sites

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- To provide adequate pre and post-operative care, in accordance with the internationally/ICRC recognized standards
- To organise and ensure items required for the ICRC pre and post-operative care are available in areas of assignments.
- Participate with the team in the maintenance and the replenishment of the FST kit (equipment, drugs and consumables) before and after an intervention, in order to be quickly operational again.
- To participate, and ensure that all items required for the nursing care are available and taken on deployment.
- Supervise support staff working at the ICRC designated surgical ward.
- To be flexible and perform tasks not covered in this job description.
- To ensure the ICRC principles for post-operative nursing care of the WW and trauma cases are followed and adapted to the circumstances
- When deployed and in consultation with the other team members, ensures that the appropriate equipment/materials are available.
- Participates in setting up the local operating theatre and the area of postoperative care, in order to provide surgical care as early as possible.
- In conjunction with ICRC Ward Nurse, participate in the follow-up of surgical cases, on-going care plan and the handover to local staff at the end of deployment.
- With the OT nurse, monitors the ongoing needs for stock and utilises Imprest system for reordering
- Attends regular hospital team meetings.
- To provide ward statistics as required and participate in providing information for monthly and quarterly reporting. Maintains admission records of patients as required.

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- Diploma or degree in Nursing or equivalent experience
- 3-5 years of experience in a busy (Hospital) with a surgical setup, Humanitarian experience an added advantage.
- Good level of English and Arabic, both written and spoken
- Good level in computer applications especially Word and Excel
- Conversant with geographical locations relevant to ICRC operations.
- Willingness to learn and adapt.
