COUNTRY PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The overall objective of the ARC South Sudan program is to assist the South Sudanese to respond and react to community needs. To achieve this objective, ARC implements a multi-sectoral program that includes primary health care, tertiary care, Nutrition, WASH and Gender based violence prevention and response activities. ARC currently works closely with the County Health Departments in large scale county wide health and nutrition programming. ARCs GBV programming is expanding its outreach mechanisms and introducing innovative new initiatives. ARC has program activities in Central and Eastern Equatoria, Northern Bahr Gazal, Unity and Upper Nile.

PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

To provide support to ARC program particularly at community & facility level. The post holder will be responsible for organizing, mobilizing and supervising HHPS to increase access to health and nutrition through health education, screening for malnutrition, home visit, home follow ups and referral in collaboration with the facility staff, CHD and ARC in Kajo-Keji County in South Sudan.

MAJOR AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY PRIMARY DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To participate in home visits and follow ups at community level.
- Supervise and support home health promoters (HHPS) and women social network group for nutrition to mobilize community to improve general health of people in Kajo-Keji County.
- Closely work with HHPs to increase access to health and nutrition information and services.
- Work with community leaders and facility staff in selecting, training and deploying of HHPs.
- In collaboration with CHD and community in developing key message for nutrition, health and hygiene promotion.
- Participate in refresher training of HHPs and other community based agents.
- Maintain records of activities accurately, consistently and complete for timely report flow from community based intervention to health facility then to CHD.

- Together with HHPs participate in mobilizing community for community based nutrition outreach screening and specific health education.
- Liaise with health facility staff, Community mobilizer for regular supervision of HHPs in the community.
- Provide written and concise reports for all supervision visits made Responsible
- Together with CHD & ARC health team conduct monthly review meeting with HHPs and other agent meetings
- Provide on -the-job training for HHPs based on identified gaps and needs.
- Organize community based outreach to screen malnourished children and for appropriate action and referrals.

Others.

- Undertake any other duties as directed by Line manager for improvement of the health status of targeted beneficiaries.
- Report on weekly bases to County & Hospital Coordinator.
