The vehicle must meet the following conditions

Elements	Condition
The vehicle status	Must be South Sudanese Registered vehicle, valid log book, insurance and properly serviced, is sound mechanically, with proper wheel alignment and balancing. It should have clear window glasses with working adjustment switches/levers. Working lighting system including the headlamps, indicators, interior light. The vehicle must meet all the South Sudan road requirements
Air conditioning	Working and clean without dust
Wheels	Must have sufficient grip of not less than 6mm depth, all four with a spare wheel. Additional spare wheel will be an added advantage. The rims must be metallic with minimum 5 studs to tighten to correct position and alignment.
Power transmission and Traction.	The vehicle may be either automatic or manual transmission, with 4 wheel traction capacity with off-road capacity
Ground clearance	The vehicle must have sufficient ground clearance of not less than 300mm, on minimum 16 inch diameter metal rims
Accessories	The vehicle must have a functioning lifting jack, fire extinguisher, emergency first aid kit, tow rope and other basic components.
Others	Must be sufficiently fueled
